HOLY SMOKE

There has been talk at our Board meetings regarding the new smoking law and it's effect on our situation. It has expanded the non smoking to the patio as it is a service area, and we do not want to give that up this summer. The docks are even in question as no guidelines have been issued by Genesee County.

Until such time as it is more defined we would ask that you refrain from smoking on any Moose property where there any chance that someone could come into contact with the second hand smoke. Our smokers have been very cooperative since we went non smoking and this is just a small step and would like to thank them for the consideration they have shown us in the past and look forward to a smooth future.

Along those same lines, there has been discussion regarding bringing coolers into the Lodge to board a boat at our dock.

Nothing has been changed as far as the Lodges' Policy to prohibit the transportation thru the Lodge of "refreshments" to a boat. The boat is tied somewhere when it is not in use, and that is the place where you should stock the boat.

Our docks are private and for the use of Moose Members only, and not for access to the swimming area for non members who will be asked to join or move their boat. It would be nice to have a method of identifying Moose Members boats with a sticker or something so we would all know with just a glance.

Work together to keep the Moose a private exclusive club for our members only and preserve the intent of the fraternity.

When you come to the Lodge by boat, please pull forward as far as possible to allow other boats to tie up. If you're a back boat, keep an eye open to make sure you move your boat if someone needs out. Remember they pulled up front so you would have space to come to the Lodge. FIRST EVER MULTI-BOAT TUBE PULL

We, a group of people who have pontoons on the lake, want to organize a multi-boat tube pull around the lake. Even though most of us are Moose members, we do not want any liability for the Lodge nor ourselves SO:

This is NOT a MOOSE sponsored EVENT, and you WILL have TO SIGN a HOLD HARMLESS statement to be involved:

There is a Meeting/party August 7th. @ 5 p.m. at the Moose, where you will pay and sign your hold harmless. We will share some time to fine tune the event with you the participants...

You will be assigned a location to begin and a time to be there. If you are Late- you could miss the boat.

You will need to bring your flotation device, a life jacket that you must wear, and a piece of rope 6 to 8 feet long to hook your flotation device to a main line. The rope should already be securely attached to the front of your "float"

The pontoons will leave from separate locations and bring their group to the middle of the lake where we will unite, and link.

It will be a leisurely "drag" for about 2-3 hours around the lake with breaks for visiting and swimming. You can of course bring your own liquid refreshment as we would not like you to get dehydrated.

Safety is a main concern and no horseplay will be tolerated with this many people involved. Yes – we hope to have 90 to 100 people take part in this unique event.

At the conclusion of the event you will be taken back to your start point by the same pontoon you have been hooked up with. If we get more people we will get more boats to pull you with. We are going for a Record number!.

The cost of the event is \$10.00 each and would like to keep this event for those 21 and older for apparent reasons.

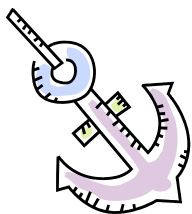
You can price your items, or we can do it for you, either way.
